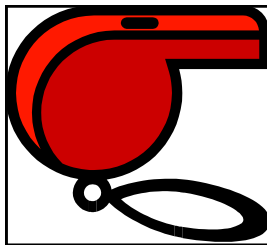

Passing of one the finest in the game of touch

On Monday 14 January we saw the passing of our own BMTA referee Robert (BOB) McWhirter with Prostate Cancer. Bob was a Coach, organiser and father figure to all his girls which included his three daughters. There were many female players that gained the opportunity to play for a supportive father a man that built his family/team on friendship, having fun working and playing together. What started out as extra fitness for school friends Sue and Maria McWhirter, Donna Tallon and Trish Keating from playing netball for St Brendan's under the Coaching of Bob lead them into one of the most exciting Women's Touch teams in the 80's and early 90's and progressed into one of Brisbane's major Touch Clubs. After one season as Yellow Cabs, (Bob was a Yellow Cab driver), netball gave way to Touch. By gaining a few more friends Jenny Tomkinson, Louise Kennealy, Amanda McGhee, Caroline Brockhurst, Karen Littman, Gayle Shaw, Karen Klingner, Karen Bucholz in 1980, Bob formed Normanettes. Sponsored by the Norman Hotel in Woolloongabba, they commenced playing in the first Brisbane Women's Touch competition. At that time there was two major Touch competitions Brisbane and Metropolitan. From 1980 to 1985 Normanettes won the Brisbane Division 1

Women's competition. In 1986 Normanettes switched to the Metropolitan Women's Competition and became Normanette / Rebels Touch Club, being joined by Kerry Norman, Suzy Boyer, and Donna Sullivan. By this stage with Bob still guiding the way, his girls were achieving many successes taking out the Queensland teams Championships in 84 and 85, as well as the Australian Club teams Championships in 84, the Metropolitan Women's titles in 86 and defeating Eagles in the 1987 final 3 - 2. These two Women's competitions have today moved into the Cobras Cup Div 1 women's. 1989 and Normanette Rebels joined with the University Touch Club which had been formed in 84 and then became UNI REBELS as we know the club today. Many of the girls from Normanettes and Rebels played for South East Queensland, Brisbane, Gold Coast, South West, Queensland and Australia. By now Susan, Maria McWhirter and team mate Kerry Norman were in the Australian Women's Open team, younger sister Alison had joined them and was in the Juniors. After reaching the pinnacle in the sport with his girls Bob took a backseat for a few years while many of the girls continued to achieve at the highest level in the early 90's with their Club Uni Rebels. Bob spent a couple of years on the

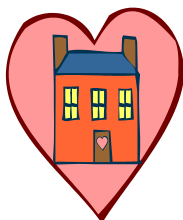
Committee of Brisbane Touch and also the Brisbane Metropolitan Committee. In later years with his grand children playing Juniors, his passion was rekindled and Bob became involved in Brisbane Juniors as a Coach and Referee and then helping out Refereeing mid week at Whites Hill.

Over thirty years with Bob at the helm, Normanettes and Uni Rebels have contributed a major role in the development of female Touch in Brisbane and Queensland. From the sport and particular the females that had the opportunity to be a part of Normanettes and Uni Rebels.

WE SAY THANK YOU – BOB for the time and effort as a father, Referee, Coach, volunteer and mentor. I am sure the free flowing exciting style that Normanettes introduced to the sport and female Touch in Queensland will always live on as part of the game.

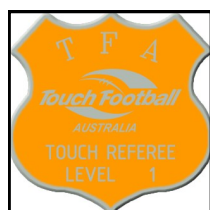

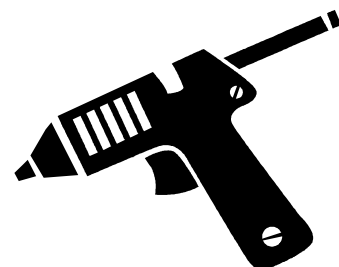
The new season will commence on Thursday 14 February. We will be looking for new inductees for 2013.
