Junior Boys – Conditions of Entry – Season 1 2025

Preamble

This document is intended to be read in conjunction with the <u>BMTA General Conditions of Entry</u>. By participating in the competition, it is expected that all players have read and understood these documents.

Rule 1 – Dates and Times

Games will consist of 2 x 17-minute halves with a 3-minute half time, teams will play 2 games per night. Games are generally be played between 4:30 and 8:30pm, the key season dates are below:

Rule 2 – Competition Types

The following competitions will be offered:

Division	Age Restriction	
Under 7's	Must be born in or after 2018	
Under 9's	Must be born in or after 2016	
Under 11's	Must be born in or after 2014	
Under 13's	Must be born in or after 2012	
Under 15's	Must be born in or after 2010	
Under 18's (Opens)	Must be born in or after 2007	

Rule 3 – Team Nominations and Fees

If you don't have a team, you can join one of our Junior Clubs, full club details can be found <u>here</u> Team Nominations must be submitted no later than Wednesday 5th of February 2025 – <u>Nominate Here</u>

Team Nominations will not be accepted until the \$150 deposit is paid. Teams will be removed from the competition if they have not paid their deposit before the nomination deadline. Under 7s and 9s Team Fee: \$1,070 (11 rounds) Under 11-Opens Team Fee: \$1,360 (10 rounds + finals)

Every individual player will need to pay a **\$52 Membership fee to QTF + TFA** when registering to play. The QTF + TFA membership is a membership that is required to be paid once every financial year.



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Full team fees must be paid by Round 3 otherwise penalties may be applied in accordance with Rule 3.2 of the <u>BMTA General Conditions of Entry</u>, which may include removal from competition.

Rule 4 – Player Registration and Playing in Multiple Teams

All players must be registered online prior to their first game. Players may join a team and register up until the registration deadline of Friday February 28th, 2025.

Players who play in <u>multiple teams for a club</u> must register into the team in the lowest grade in the youngest age group. Players are not permitted to play down but may play in a higher grade or age group <u>for the same club</u> if they're correctly registered for a lower grade or younger age group.

Example: A player correctly registered in the U13C division may play in any team in a higher age group or division with the same club including 13B, 13A, 15B, 15D or Open C.

A player may register and play for <u>another team outside of their club</u> in an older age group but may not then register or play for the club team in any older age group.

Example: A player is registered and has played for Club 1 in the 13A but has also registered and played for Club 2 in the 15B. The player is not permitted to also play for Club 1 in the 15 or Open age group.

Rule 5 – Uniform

All players in a team must wear a matching playing shirt/singlet/jersey with a unique 1 or 2 digit number on the back for identification purposes, fills ins or players not in uniform must hire a bib from BMTA.

Rule 6 – Team Grading and Finals Format

The first 2 rounds of the competition will be grading rounds. Following the completion of the 2nd round BMTA will undertake a full review of each team's results and regrade teams if required. Competition points will be accumulated and the finals series will be structured per the <u>BMTA General Conditions of Entry</u>.

Rule 7 – Under 7 and 9 Modified Rules

All Under 7 and 9 divisions will play modified rules per Rule 2.5 in the BMTA General Conditions of Entry.

Rule 8 – Forfeits

Forfeiting a match is strongly discouraged as it negatively impacts the opposing team. Where a team has no choice but to forfeit, they must notify BMTA no later than 3pm on the day of competition by emailing <u>competitions@bmta.com.au</u>. **Teams notifying BMTA after this point will be deducted competition points** and may have other penalties applied per the <u>BMTA General Conditions of Entry</u>.

Rule 9 – Team Delegate Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the Team Delegate to ensure:

- All players are eligible and registered online before they take the field
- At least 1 adult (over 18 years of age) attends and is responsible for the team conduct each game
- All players, officials and associated spectators comply with the TFA Code of Conduct
- Players comply with all uniform requirements



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- Team competition fees are paid in full by the deadlines in <u>Rule 3</u>
- All players are aware of the <u>TFA 8th Edition Playing Rules</u>
- They are aware of all rules set out in this document and the BMTA General Conditions of Entry
